## Take it to the limit

Confused about which city limits end where? Soon there won't be any room for doubt about Leander's boundaries.

The city 20 miles north of Austin is working with local businesses to erect 11 stone entrances around the city, weighing in at 12 tons each. Developer Bill Hinckley's The Lookout Group, **J.C. Evans Construction**, Apache Graders and Creative Green Design are working with the city to develop the 10-foot-high entrances and accompanying xeriscaping.

Five of the monolithic structures are under way at Lakeline Boulevard, Bagdad Road, U.S. Highway 183, U.S. Highway 183-A and Ronald Reagan Boulevard.

The "council's initiative, our businesses' interest and staff's persistence to do something that is representative of Leander and the **Hill Country** will be reflected in these entrances," Leander City Manager Biff Johnson said.
